This course is a first course on financial management and aims to make an introduction to the fundamental concepts of finance theory, including goals and governance of firms, financial markets and institutions, time value of money, valuation of bonds and stocks, investment criteria, short-term financial planning, capital structure, payout policy, and working capital management. This course provides a basic knowledge of finance theory and elementary analytical tools which will be needed for solving practical problems in work environment, and for more advanced finance courses.
